POVERTY IN NICARAGUA

Almost half of all Nicaraguans live below the national poverty line

41% of Nicaraguan homes have dirt floors

Approximately 15% of households nationally do not have access to safe drinking water

Approximately 48% of households nationally do not have adequate sanitation solutions (toilets or latrines)

These impoverished families in Nicaragua live in deplorable, insecure conditions and suffer serious health risks due to a lack of safe drinking water and sanitary solutions

RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS

In conjunction with on-the-ground partners, Matthew 25: Ministries has participated in community development projects that have encompassed:

• Building more than 175 new homes and residential latrines

• Upgrading existing homes with more substantial, weather-tight construction such as elevated concrete foundations and paint

• Installing wells, water filters, hand pumps or individual spigots that provide clean drinking water

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS

In addition to homes, Matthew 25: Ministries has funded the construction of two warehouses, a community center, a feeding center, a multipurpose building and a hydro-electric facility in select communities.

We also sponsor agricultural and small business programs that benefit and strengthen entire communities.
