POVERTY IN NICARAGUA

Nicaragua is the poorest country in Central America, and the second poorest country in the Western Hemisphere

Approximately 30% of the population lives on less than \$2 per day

3 out of 10 Nicaraguan families live in inadequate conditions: overcrowding, poor quality of housing and insufficient services

These impoverished families in Nicaragua live in deplorable, insecure conditions and suffer serious health risks due to a lack of safe drinking water and sanitary solutions

RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS

In conjunction with on-the-ground partners, Matthew 25: Ministries has participated in community development projects that have encompassed:

- Building more than 175 new homes and residential latrines
- Upgrading existing homes with more substantial, weather-tight construction such as elevated concrete foundations and paint
- Installing wells, water filters, hand pumps or individual spigots that provide clean drinking water

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS

In addition to homes, Matthew 25: Ministries has funded the construction of two warehouses, a community center, a feeding center, a multi-purpose building and a hydro-electric facility in select communities.

We also sponsor agricultural and small business programs that benefit and strengthen entire communities.
