

CLOTHING DONATION BIN PROGRAM



Matthew 25: Ministries provides clothing donation bins to businesses and organizations throughout Greater Cincinnati as an easy and convenient way for these organizations to help us serve those in need.

Matthew 25 places a semi-permanent, metal donation bin in an unused parking space or similar unused area on the partner's property and will maintain the bin. There is no cost involved for this service.

ITEMS THAT CAN BE PLACED IN BINS

- New and gently-used clothing and shoes
- Adult clothing
- Children's clothing
- Business attire
- Scrubs and uniforms
- New and gently-used household linens
- New underwear and socks **in original packaging**
- New and gently-used shoes

13 gallon-size trash bags (readily available in most stores) are the recommended size for donation packaging.

BINS

Bins are approximately 6' H x 4' W x 4' D

- Donation bins require a flat, hard surface
- Matthew 25 will make weekly pick ups to the bin location to retrieve donations
- Donation bins must have adequate space to ensure easy access for pick ups

BENEFITS

- Enhance community connection by drawing new people to your facility with donations
- Expand your outreach to the community and the world
- Help people in need by being a donation collection point for products that will go to the poorest of the poor and disaster victims worldwide

The gift of nearly new, comfortable, properly fitting clothing has a huge impact on a recipient's physical and emotional well-being. In addition to providing better hygiene and improved overall self-esteem, an adult who receives new clothing may find the confidence to successfully interview for a job, to seek a better job or qualify for a promotion, while children are more likely to attend and do well in school.
