Matthew 25: Ministries is constantly monitoring weather systems worldwide so our Disaster Response Team is aware of potential threats ahead of time. This information helps our team activate within hours of an event, and often appear on-site within days of a disaster occurrence.

During disasters, Matthew 25 focuses on moving large amounts of aid into the affected areas. We utilize a fleet of specialty vehicles to distribute initial loads of aid and provide support services. Our Disaster Response Team also sets up distribution channels for future shipments.
