EDUCATION

Matthew 25's Global Village Experience fulfills our commitment to education, allowing visitors to experience the living conditions and lifestyles of the poorest of the poor and disaster victims.

CORPORATIONS

Many local corporations utilize Matthew 25 as a way of avoiding the expense and environmental impact of landfilling. Through these and other U.S. corporations, Matthew 25 saves millions of pounds of product from the landfill each year.

PROGRAMS

Matthew 25 works with hundreds of local partners through a variety of programs and services.

In 2021, Matthew 25: Ministries:

- Provided over 18,000 pounds of COVID-19 relief aid to almost 50 local partners
- Distributed over 67,000 pounds of non-perishable food and drinks to 40 local pantries and shelters through the Hunger 5K Food Drive
- Provided approximately 1 million pounds of food to local pantries and shelters through the Fresh Food Program
- Distributed food, clothing, hygiene items, baby products, medical supplies and more to local partners for underserved members of the Greater Cincinnati community
- Sponsored a holiday event for children with life-threatening illnesses and their families
