VOLUNTEER GUIDELINES FOR CHILDREN

There are many jobs in the warehouse that children of all ages can do. All children under 16 years of age MUST be accompanied by an adult at all times.

Children are welcome under the following guidelines:

- Children under 8 1 adult for every child
- Children 9-11 1 adult for every 2 children
- Children 12-16 1 adult for every 3 children
- 16 and over may work alone; however, if volunteering in groups of more than 5, at least 1 adult must be present

DRESS CODE

Volunteers perform a variety of activities in the Processing Center. As this is a warehouse environment, we recommend wearing comfortable, close-toed shoes, as well as clothing you don't mind getting dirty or damaged. The temperature in our Processing Center fluctuates with each season, so please dress accordingly.
